

# CERTIFICATE IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE (CEL)

Selection into this SIM programme is solely based upon recommendation by the Admissions Committee for those who have applied for the Management Foundation Studies (MFS) and/or Diploma programmes, but failed to meet the English language requirements.

The Certificate in English Language (CEL) programme is developed and awarded by Singapore Institute of Management, Singapore. It focuses on four essential skills in language learning – Listening, Reading, Speaking and Writing. It features three levels:

- Pre-Intermediate (Level 3)
- Intermediate (Level 4)
- Upper-Intermediate (Level 5)

Duration	Intakes
3 months Full-time (Each level)	January, April, July & October

## Mode of Delivery

Classroom learning comprising:

- Activities
- Exercises
- Lectures

Each lesson is typically five hours.

## Assessment

- Written Exams
- Listening Exams
- Speaking Exams

There are two types of assessments at each level:

- Mid-Course Assessment (MCA)
- End-of-Course Assessment (EOC)

## Candidature Period: 9 months

There will be no refund or recourse should the student fail to complete the programme within the candidature period.

## Minimum Class Size: 20

In the event that the class cannot commence due to low take-up rate, applicants will be informed within one month before programme commencement.

## Admission Criteria

Depending on your English language proficiency, you may be placed at Pre-Intermediate (Level 3) or Intermediate (Level 4) or Upper-Intermediate (Level 5).

2. *If you do not have IELTS or TOEFL or PTE Academic scores, you may be required to sit for an English Placement Test conducted by SIM to determine your English language proficiency. The SIM English Placement Test results will be valid for one year from the date of the test.*
